Come with him and she didn't want, she wanted to stay with Teklak, because he was like a father to her. After the war, he took her out to the barn and learn her how to walk. She cannot see the sunlight from the darkness. And after the war she went to Lublin and came to emigrate to Israel in 1950. And built a family with Israel Zimmerman from her hometown Turobin.
