I know nothing about the house [of 41 Krawiecka Street where my father had lived]. Nothing at all. He told me [about Tomasz Czajkowski, who came to Israel a few years ago, as a student, and made the interview with him about this house]. I tried to understand what the purpose is and, when I know he's doing his master's degree in it – it's OK, that makes sense. I didn't ask what he had asked my father and what my father had answered. I didn't ask because they are not telling us, until now, about their lives there.

I asked [my father about the interview], so he said: "He asked me questions about my childhood". So I said: "OK, what did you answer?" "What you ask? I answered, that's it". So I understood that it's for him enough and I didn't ask anymore.

I haven't seen the list of residents of Krawiecka before today, this is the first time. There are names here that I've heard and I've probably seen the children that are written here, I've seen them here, at home... A lot of them are abroad, all over the world, in Canada and the United States, and wherever, and whenever someone from my father's childhood and my mother's childhood came here to visit us – they were here, at home – the only thing that I knew was: "That's my friend from home". That's it.
